

## TUKULU CHENIN A WINNER!

With a circulation of over 100 000 readers, the US Wine Enthusiast Magazine definitely has clout in the American wine world. If your wine scores well in their magazine, you have reason to celebrate.

So that is why we are so proud of the **Tukulu Chenin Blanc 2005** scoring a magnificent 90 points in the most recent issue of this well-known wine publication.

Adian Fry made this wine from grapes grown in the deep, red Tukulu soils on the farm Papkuilsfontein near Darling. Just 25km from the sea, the farm enjoys relatively cool temperatures and is protected from the harsh winds by the surrounding hills.

The low yielding vineyards can therefore produce grapes with excellent fruit concentration that can stand up to a few months barrel maturation for added complexity and richness.

Adian describes the wine as mouth filling with melon flavours on the nose and a hint of musk on the palate. He enjoys a chilled glass of **Tukulu Chenin Blanc 2005** on its own as an aperitif but says it would also go well with a variety of lightly spiced or cream-based dishes.
